Benefits of Membership

Access to Clubhouse

Parents/Guardians of Junior members aged 14 or over may request a card entry key to access the clubhouse. Junior members are welcome to use the clubhouse facilities, but please be aware that the upstairs hall and balcony are strictly out of bounds. Juniors should not remain in the bar area, unless accompanied by an adult club member.

Junior members under the age of 14 are permitted to use the club facilities only when supervised by a parent or legal guardian (or another adult acting with their authority), or a sibling aged 14 or over. NB This does not apply to organised coaching sessions.

Balls and floodlighting are provided by the club and included in the cost of membership.

Mature Play

Junior members who demonstrate a mature standard of play and who, in the opinion of the coaches and the club captain are able to participate in club adult tennis activities, may do so as *upgraded* Juniors without additional charges. This includes participation in: adult rota sessions, evening fixed-doubles /singles and team matches.

Junior Members Regulations / Guidance

The full Regulations and Rule Book are available on request from the membership secretary and will be issued with application forms for new members as a matter of course. Junior members and their responsible parent/guardian are expected to observe these regulations and the club's Rule Book. The below is a summary of the key requirements:

- Members and guests will behave with respect and consideration towards each other and the club facilities.
- Members and others using the club must abide by the rules and disciplinary code of the LTA. In particular, players must not make obscene gestures, swear, kick or throw a racket, ball or other object in anger and must show proper respect towards other players and spectators.
- Junior members must ONLY use the junior balls which are found in the storage box outside courts 5 & 6.
- Members will observe the club Visitors policy for non-member guests and ensure they write both theirs and the visitor's name in the Visitors book, as well as ensuring the relevant fee is paid.
- Suitable clothing and in particular **tennis shoes** with non-marking soles must be worn during play.
- Juniors may have access to the club at times when there is no adult supervision, but do so with their parent's/guardian's permission and acceptance of all risks and liabilities and agree to act appropriately, with due regard to the health and safety of themselves and others.
- Members are asked to be mindful of security; they must not admit people to the club premises that they do not recognise as authorised persons. On leaving the club, members are asked to make sure the premises are secure, if they are the last to leave. In particular, the clubhouse patio doors and entrance door must be locked.
- Members are asked to treat the clubhouse and facilities with respect and help to keep them clean and tidy. Your attention is drawn to the fact that *the premises are CCTV monitored*. The club reserves the right to take action against members or responsible parents/guardians if they are found to be in breach of these rules.
